Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Frank Kasyan, Superintendent of Schools – Dr. Kasyan thanked the custodial staff, technology team, Dr. Kasyan's administrative team and office secretaries, transportation, teachers and paraprofessionals. Dr. Kasyan also stated that many staff members put in their own hours to apply for grants, 2010 Go Green Grant, Mrs. Colleen McGettigan and Kathy Mandra. Presentation:

Ocean First Foundation - Go Green Grant Award – presented by Ms. Shannon Butler, Assistant Vice President, Ocean First Bank – presented \$2,500 to Frog Pond Elementary School. Ms. Frasca thanked Mrs. Himchak, who wrote the grant.

Open to Public:

The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves on school matters of community interest as cited in Policy No. 0167.

The public may comment on any item on the agenda at this time. General public comment will occur later in the meeting.

M. Malashevitz, 40 My Way – Ms. Malashevitz stated that she was present at the meeting to return the backpack that was given to her child to show what’s wrong with Little Egg Harbor Board of Education and went on to give facts regarding the back packs that were distributed at the Back to School Jam. Ms. Malashevitz also stated that Mr. Cox may have made a substantial profit from Little Egg Harbor Board of Education and found it “flimsy” that the Board of Education has nothing to do with the Education Foundation. Ms. Malashevitz stated that the teachers cannot do their jobs without supplies and went on to say that her goal is to bring out the truth. Ms. Malashevitz stated that she would like to see the Education Foundation and the PTA work together and connect administration and school needs. Ms. Malashevitz noted that there is a lack of field trips and that the Education Foundation and the PTA could help provide this for the children and went on to ask that parents get involved.

Mr. Coronato, Little Egg Harbor Board of Education Attorney – Mr. Coronato stated that this Board of Education has nothing to do with the Education Foundation and went on to say that the board did not authorize the purchase of the backpacks, the Education Foundation did. Mr. Coronato stated that donations were solicited for school supplies and that money could not be used for other purposes. Mr. Coronato stated that businesses did a good thing and it’s equal to be distributed to all. Mr. Coronato stated that some will use the backpacks and some will not and that the bottom line is the board had a no vote and the money didn’t come from taxes. Mr. Coronato directed Ms. Malashevitz to go to the Education Foundation and went onto say that she was in the wrong “church”. Mr. Coronato stated that nobody is saying that you are wrong, you are just in the wrong spot. Mr. Coronato explained to Ms. Malashevitz that the district is fortunate that businesses will donate in this economy and the donation was for basic needs and that both Mr. Coronato and the board understand Ms. Malashevitz’s concerns.

Ms. Malashevitz stated that the Education Foundation and the Board of Education disconnect and that they should work together and went on to mention the uniform issue brought up in March. Mr. Coronato replied that you cannot help all the people all the time and again stated this was a basic need.

Ms. Malashevitz stated that supplies should be allocated to classrooms and it seems a waste of funds when teachers are sending home a list of supplies needed.

Mrs. Perrino stated that many developers have come to Little Egg Harbor with extremely diverse population. Mrs. Perrino stated that we have to make every effort to provide help to all. Mrs. Perrino thanked the board for their time, talent and treasures and for serving our community. Ms. Frasca thanked Mrs. Perrino and asked to please send our love to Fred.

Board Forum:

Mrs. Sink - trustee of the Education Foundation - Mrs. Sink noted that the Education Foundation goal is to not furnish supplies to classrooms but to bring businesses to education. Mrs. Sink went on to say that Mr. Cox did make money and the foundation did solicit funds and the left over supplies will go to the teachers. Mrs. Sink thanked the board for allowing this to happen.

Mr. Todd Lawrence – New Jersey School Jobs – Mr. Lawrence stated that his company was more than happy to donate \$500 for supplies and School Jam was a great opportunity for businesses to further relationships and stated that he would be glad to do it again.
